

## MAGAZINE DONATIONS TO LIBRARIES & INSTITUTIONS AROUND THE WORLD

This year the Pitcairn and Norfolk Islands Society participated in a joint project to donate the complete run of *The UK Log* on DVD to more than two dozen philatelic libraries on four continents.

The joint mailing to 28 libraries in nine countries in Europe, North America, Australia and Africa was undertaken in cooperation with the Pitcairn Islands Study Group and the St. Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha Philatelic Society.

Discs containing *The UK Log* were sent to 26 philatelic libraries plus the U.S. Library of Congress and the Pitcairn Island library.

PISG President Ted Cookson copied the discs and arranged for the mailings to Australia, Canada, Germany, The Netherlands, Norway, Pitcairn Island, South Africa, United Kingdom, and the United States.

The following European institutions were included: Munchner Stadt Bibliothek Am Gasteig in Munich; Philatelistische Bibliothek Hamburg in Hamburg; KNBF Library in Baarn, The Netherlands; Oslo Filatelistklubb in Oslo; The British Library Philatelic Collections in London; Postal History Society in Winterborne, Stickland, Dorset; Royal Philatelic Society London in London; The British Postal Museum and Archive in London; and National Philatelic Society Library in Wokingham, Berks.

## ACADIA PORTHOLE SOLD ON EBAY



Now here's something you don't see every day . . . and you probably won't see any others for sale. In February this year an incomplete porthole from the *Acadia* was sold on eBay for £422.00 with the following description: "I have taken the items from the wreck in 1989 when we discovered the wreck first. I own photos from Ducie and the ship underwater and ashore. Nowadays it has been declared a historical monument by the Pitcairn people and nobody is allowed to more take items. One of the four huge anchors we transported to Pitcairn where it is a monument now."
